### Animal List

#### SESSION ONE

- **Bearded Dragon** *Pogona barbatus*  
Feeding on worms or crickets and posing, possibly standing on hind legs.
- **Sungazer** *Cordylus giganteus*  
Feeding on worms or crickets and posing on rock.
- **Flap-neck Chameleon** *Chamaeleo dilepis*  
Feeding on crickets and posing on small tree or bush.
- **Giant Plated Lizards** *Gerrosaurus validus*  
Feeding on brightly coloured flowers and posing on rocks.
- **Golden Brown Baboon Spider** *Augacephalus sp.*  
Can be handled and will pose for good macro shots.
- **Flat Rock Scorpion** *Hadogenes troglodytes*  
Can be handled and will pose for good macro shots.
- **Black Hairy Thick Tailed Scorpion** *Parabuthus transvaalicus*  
**Venomous** Can be photographed on a rock or slight indentation on the ground.
- Walk through the park and photograph animals in own time. *(Optional)*

## SESSION TWO

- **Green Mamba** *Dendroaspis angusticeps*  
**Venomous** Docile and can be photographed in a small tree or bush.
- **Black Mamba** *Dendroaspis polylepis*  
**Venomous** A little erratic and has to be held while doing close up shots but can be released in a small bush or tree for wider shots.
- **Boomslang** *Dispholidus typus*  
**Venomous** Docile and can be photographed in a small tree or bush.
- **Puff Adder** *Bitis arietans*  
**Venomous** Can try feeding this snake a naturally coloured rat. Slow moving and can be photographed on the ground.
- **Snouted Cobra** *Naja annulifera*  
**Venomous** Fast moving but should stand up with hood spread.
- Walk through the park and photograph animals in own time. *(Optional)*
